This wonderful hat represents perhaps the most classic styles of the 1920s, as wearable today as it was 90 years ago. Depending on fabrics and trims, it can look elegantly tailored or fashionably sporty. We will discuss trimmings and as time allows, construct a ribbon cockade for the finished hat.

- Bring
- 3/8 yd 54" wide material without nap
silk, rayon, cotton, linen or light weight woolens suggested
 - 3/8yd 24" buckram to line brim
 - 3 yds 3/4" wide ribbon for trim
 - 2 yds 1/2" ribbon for binding
 - basic sewing supplies: scissors, pins, sewing needles, thread, sewing machine (with knowledge of sewing machine use).

INSTRUCTOR: Janyce Engan has been teaching various forms of sewing and needlework in the Bay Area for over 20 years, blending a deep grounding in vintage fashion and an extensive knowledge of a wide range of techniques together with a liberal dash of good humor and patience.

Janyce is the owner of the "Vintage Pattern Lending Library" established for the purpose of preserving, archiving,, and replicating historic fashion patterns from 1840 through 1950, vintage sewing publications, and fashion prints of the past.
