- Two balls “Zephyr” yarn,
  - Circular needles, #4, 24”
  - Small stitch markers
  - Basic knitting tools: scissors, tape measure, row counter

**INSTRUCTOR:** Amy Keefe has supported herself by knitting for her entire adult life. She helped put an all men’s knitting club in the spotlight in lower Manhattan while instructing children, adults, seniors, celebrities and her own mother the art of knitting.
